IGNITE What is IGNITE DAVIE?

- IGNITE DAVIE will invest in our students by paying tuition, required fees and up to \$250 per semester for text books for every eligible Davie student who attends DDCC full time.
- **IGNITE DAVIE** is NOT based on academic merit or financial need. It is "place-based" and is open to students who live in Davie County and go to school here.
- IGNITE DAVIE will help our students pursue a certificate, degree or diploma without incurring debt, so our students will be better educated and prepared to join the workforce of the future.








Common Application commonapp.org

- Application essay prompts are available now





Colleges require this number to verify you are an "in-state" student. If you do not fill out this information correctly, you may be asked to pay out-of-state tuition!





What Else Should You Expect?

- Essays Your student will have to respond to a variety of prompts. Your student may expect to see one about overcoming something major in their life.
- Activities It's important to show how your student is involved in school and their community. Colleges also look for leadership experience and any awards he/she may have received.
- Recommendations Ask your teachers, counselors, pastors, and/or friends early! Three or four weeks is the best practice. Be sure to ask the individual before adding his/her name to the application.

Applying for Federal Financial Aid

- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
 - Required for all types of <u>federal</u> aid (necessary for other sources as well)
 - Complete every year
 - 2023-24 FAFSA available December ish
 (be sure to choose the correct year)
 - Use 2022 income tax information for 2023-24 FAFSA (use IRS Data Retrieval, if possible)
 - Be aware of school deadlines or priority dates
 - May include multiple schools
 - Be very careful with entry of date of birth and social security numbers



Post-secondary: Any education option after high school

Commonapp: A website that allows student to complete one main

application for multiple colleges

FAFSA: Free Application for Federal Student Aid

EFC: Expected Family Contribution (this number will be given to

you after completing your FAFSA

RDS: Residency Determination Service (Process all NC colleges

use to determine in-state tuition)

Early Decision: A binding application (if you get in - you will go)

Early Action: A non-binding application

Institutional Aid: Financial aid offered by the college

Subsidized Loans: Student loans where interest does not accrue

while you are in school

Unsubsidized Loans: Student loans where the interest does

accrue while you are in school.

Verification: A process where FAFSA will request additional information from you (Roughly 10% of families will go through verification each year.
